The Junior Seau Foundation was established in 1992 to raise money and resources for programs that inspire young people to face life's challenges with enthusiasm, hope and dignity. Junior Seau uses his platform in the National Football League to raise money and resources for programs that help young people face their challenges with confidence. The Foundation's mission is:

To educate and empower young people through the support of child abuse prevention, drug and alcohol awareness, recreational opportunities, anti-juvenile delinquency efforts and complimentary educational programs.

As part of Junior's effort to help young people achieve their dreams, the Foundation established the *Scholars of Excellence* program in 1992. Through the *Scholars of Excellence* program, promising high school students who have the ability to be successful in college will receive financial support so that they may achieve their goals through higher education. Scholarship will be awarded in the amounts ranging from \$2,500 to \$5,000.

Scholarships will be awarded to deserving graduating high school seniors from throughout San Diego County. Scholarships are one-time payments for their respective awards.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

1. Applicants must be graduating from a San Diego County high school, who has committed to attend a four year college or university beginning the fall semester 2010.
2. Applicants must be United States Citizens or have permanent residency status.
3. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better and satisfactory citizenship in school.
4. Applicants must complete the Scholarship Application Form.
5. Applicants must include 2 letters of recommendation from an administrator, teacher, counselor or community service mentor.
6. Applicants must include an **official transcript**, which must be mailed to the Junior Seau Foundation directly from your high school.

If selected, funds can only be used for tuition, room and board, or meal plans.

Scholarship checks will be mailed directly to the school in August/September 2010 and deposited into the student's account. These scholarships are secondary to any other funds the student receives and any unused funds must be returned.
